Chemical manufacturers or importers are required to classify the hazards of chemicals which they produce or import, and all employers are required to provide information to their employees about the hazardous chemicals to which they are exposed, by means of a hazard communication program, labels and other forms of warning, safety data sheets, and information and training. In addition, distributors are required to transmit the required information to employers. If, under normal conditions of use, a manufactured item meets the definition of an "article" or does not meet the definition of "hazardous chemical" by the UN GHS (as adopted by the OSHA and the European Chemicals Agency) then *the item is exempted from hazard communication requirements such as SDS*.
